To participate in the challenge:

- 1. Download a copy of the lab cleanup BINGO card
- 2. Between 9/1/23 and 10/31/23, fill in the dates for the completed activities listed on the BINGO card.
 - a. The objective is to complete as many of the activities as possible listed on the BINGO card.
 - b. You do not need to complete all activities listed on the BINGO card to submit your entry.
- 3. As your lab completes activities listed on the card, add the date of completion to the BINGO card.
- 4. Submit your BINGO card, with the completed dates entered, to regina1@vt.edu by 5pm on 11/9/2023
 - a. Only one BINGO card per laboratory group will be accepted. If multiple entries are submitted, the first submission will be used as the official entry.
- 5. The lab group that completes the most BINGO card activities will win the trophy. In the event that there is a tie, the winner will be chosen through a random drawing between those lab groups that were tied.
 - a. Prior to announcing the winner of the trophy, a member of the IBCP and/or EHS Biosafety Group will come to the lab to verify that the dated activities were performed.
